Dear Sir/ Madame:

*Assalamu alaykum warahmatullahi wabarakatuhu!*

As you already know, there will be a Bangsamoro Assembly to be held on November 4, 2017 at the Old Maguindanao Provincial Capitol. We expect to have hundreds of thousands to around one million (1,000,000) participants, making this a historic event in the history of the Bangsamoro.

For an orderly registration of delegates/ attendees to the Bangsamoro Assembly on November 3 (arrival) and 4, 2017, please see the attached registration form, with the following instructions:

1. Kindly download and print out **(in a legal size paper “8.5 x 14 inches”)** the attached form and reproduce it in the number sufficient for your delegation, as proposed in the following items;
2. Each vehicle carrying your delegation from your Provincial Committee/ Agency/ Organization should have with them 3 copies of the form;
3. The listing of names in the registration form will commence once all passengers are aboard the designated vehicles.
4. Each vehicle shall have a designated leader, who shall write his/her name and sign the form on the bottom left (above the “Submitted by”);
5. Each of the 3 forms shall contain all the names of the passengers of the vehicle, signed by them, and reflect all the basic information required in the form; and
6. The triplicate shall be used as follows:
  - a. One copy shall be submitted to the Committee on Documentation and Registration (see guideline #7 below);
  - b. One copy shall be retained by the designated leader of the delegates in the vehicle;
  - c. One copy can be used for other purposes, e.g., if checkpoints ask for names of the delegates in the vehicle.
7. The collection of the copy for the Committee on Documentation and Registration shall be done at different registration stations/posts on November 3 or 4, 2017, as follows:

<b>Registration Station</b>	<b>Location</b>	<b>Covered Provincial Committees/ Geographical Areas</b>
Post 3:	Highway near BLM I	Delegations from Davao provinces, North Cotabato, and other participants from Maguindanao Province
Post 4:	Da'wah Center	Delegations from Cotabato City, South Cotabato Sultan Kudarat, Sarangani, General Santos City, Upi, South Upi, Datu Odin Sinsuat, Rajah Buayan, Kabuntalan, Datu Saudi, Datu Piang, Talayan, Talitay, Ampatuan and other Maguindanao provinces
Post 5:	Simuay Junction	Delegations from Sulu, Basilan, Tawi-Tawi, Zamboanga peninsula provinces, Northern Mindanao, Marawi City, Lanao provinces, Parang, Matanog, Barira, Buldon
Post 6:	Darapanan (near BIAF Post 1)	Delegations from Darapanan and nearby areas

There shall also be two (2) registration stations (Stations 1 & 2) by the gate of the Old Capitol but these shall be used for the registration of individuals/ unorganized groups who may also want to attend the Assembly, as well as those who are not able to register at the above designated stations.
